Members and Chairperson

The Northern Ireland Commissioner for Children and Young People (NICCY) invites applications for the appointment of a chairperson and two members to NICCY's Audit and Risk Committee.

The Committee

The role of the Audit and Risk Committee is to provide a means of independent assurance and objective review of NICCY's internal control mechanisms, including financial, non-financial and risk management processes.

The Audit and Risk Committee meets in Belfast and meetings shall be held at least four times per year, with additional meetings as required. Remuneration of £265 per meeting is available for members and £320 for the Chair. All posts will have a three year tenure from the date of appointment.

MEMBERS (Ref MAR10/ARC1)

Committee members should have:

- A commitment to the mission, vision and values of NICCY;
- A broad understanding of public sector governance and, particularly, accountability structures;
- Five years' experience of working at Board level in **at least one** of the following areas:
 - Accounting;
 - Audit;
 - Risk management;
 - Specialist issues pertinent to an organisation's business.

CHAIRPERSON (Ref MAR10/ARC2)

The Chairperson should possess the above criteria and possess two years' experience of chairing meetings at Board level and five years' substantive experience of working at Board level in **at least two** of the following areas:

- Accounting;
- Audit;
- Risk management;
- Specialist issues pertinent to an organisation's business.
