By signing up to an agreement called the Convention on the Rights of the Child, the government has promised to make sure that all children and young people have everything they need to live a safe and healthy life.

NICCY wants to find out if the government is keeping its promises to children and young people in Northern Ireland - that's why we are asking lots of different young people to answer some questions about their lives.

If you would like to take part in this, please answer the questions below. If you don't know the answer, or don't want to answer any question, please just move on to the next one.

Before you start, we need to tell you that:

1. We will use what you, and other young people, tell us to write a report – but we will not use your name anywhere in the report.
2. If you tell us that you or any other child or young person is being hurt, or that they might be hurt, we cannot keep this secret. We will have to pass on this information to someone who can do something about it.
3. Everyone who fills in a questionnaire can enter our prize draw. If you want to do this, remember to fill in the prize draw form and send it back with your questionnaire.

IMPORTANT: If you are 10 or younger, you will need to get your parent/carer to sign this to show they are happy for you to answer these questions.
