Hi I'm Koulla, the Northern Ireland Commissioner for Children and Young People, or 'NICCY'. It's my job to make sure government keeps its promises, so you get the rights you should have.

Find out what the UN says government needs to do better, for children and young people in Northern Ireland.



In June 2016 the UN' published a report known as Concluding Observations on how the UK is doing at keeping the promises it made to children and young people through the UNCRC". This report shows government The Right Way to make sure Children's Rights become a reality for you. We want to let you know about some of the things it said that are important for Northern Ireland, and how you can get involved in campaigning for your rights.



The Northern Ireland government should make plans to show how it is working to keep the promises it has made to you.

#### **Your Education**

Government should make sure that all children are supported to do the best they can at school and make sure that they know about their rights.





## Extra Protection you might need

When children do things that are against the law, the government should try to help them not to do it again, instead of using the law to punish them.

### Keeping you Safe

The Government must do more to keep all children safe at home, in schools and everywhere else.

\*\*The UNCRC or Convention on the Rights of the Child is an agreement signed by many countries that lists promises made to children and young people so that they will be treated equally and fairly.

#### Negative Stereotyping

The Government should take action to make sure that people don't treat children, especially teenagers, badly because of their age.

#### **Mental Health**

The Government should spend more money in mental health services for children and young people and make sure they get the support they need, when they need it.

#### You can make a difference

Get involved in making sure the Government in Northern Ireland listens to the recommendations the UN has made in its report. You can talk to your local MLA or let NICCY know what you think about how Government is keeping the promises they made to you through the UNCRC.
